



1) Harmonisation and Common Methodologies

- Pre-, Peri- and Co-Normative Research: JRC's Work
 Programme
- Reference Materials and Measurements
- Technical Working Groups and Committees
- scientific support to the preparation and follow-up of mandates
- certification: undertaken only in limited cases





2) Anticipation, Awareness Raising, Capacity Building

- horizon scanning and foresight
- facilitation: bringing together scientific & standardisation communities
- Commission Measurements & Standards Help Desk
- Capacity building, particularly training






3) Internationalisation

- Neighbourhood Countries










The JRC's facilitating role

JRC offers:


Helpdesk for Measurements & Standards
